Sea Change - Tai Timu Tai Pari

You may be aware that I have recently been appointed as the new independent chair for the Sea Change Tai Timu Tai Pari Stakeholder Working Group (**SWG**).

You will also be aware that, unfortunately, Alan Proctor is not able to continue in his role as a member of the SWG. Consequently, a replacement member to represent the recreational fishing sector will need to be appointed.

The SWG Terms of Reference state:

"If for any reason a member of the SWG is unable to continue in the role then the chair in conjunction with the member and the interest group or groups they represent will identify a potential replacement for the member. There must be consensus support for the replacement candidate by the other members of the SWG and the replacement must also be confirmed by the [Project Steering Group]".

I would appreciate the Council's view on a potential replacement member for the SWG. Perhaps we could discuss by phone the best way to approach this matter?

The SWG is having its next meeting on 19/20 October and ideally we would be in a position to have the replacement member attend that first meeting.
