

Recreational daily bag limits and size restrictions for finfish

This document provides an overview of updated recreational daily bag limits for finfish taken in the Auckland/Kermadec, Central, Challenger, South-East or Southland/Sub-Antarctic recreational fishing areas. It is designed to support decisions made as part of the review of recreational daily bag limits for finfish.

The specific regulations for recreational daily bag limits are contained within the <u>Fisheries (Amateur</u> Fishing) Regulations 2013.

Auckland/Kermadec fishing area daily bag limits and size restrictions

There is a **combined maximum daily bag limit of 20** for finfish. Individual species limit must also not be exceeded.

Challenger fishing area daily bag limits and size restrictions

There is a **combined maximum daily bag limit of 20** for finfish. Individual species limit must also not be exceeded.

* You can possess up to 4 blue cod in the Tasman Area (includes the Marborough Sounds Area) if you can prove that no more than 2 of those blue cod were taken on any one day from the Tasman Area. This restriction applies if you caught the fish from outside of the Tasman Area and want to transit into the Tasman Area.

** You can possess up to 20 blue cod in the Challenger Kahurangi if you can prove that no more than 10 blue cod were taken on any one day.

¹Where permitted, headed state minimum length is 24cm and is measured from the base of the side pectoral fin to the middle ray of the tail fin.
