New Zealand Sport Fishing Council Advocacy for North Island issues





March 2023

The New Zealand Sport Fishing Council (NZSFC) was established in 1957 to advocate for recreational fishing interests. Incorporated clubs in the North Island affiliated to (the then NZ Big Game Fishing Council) the national body so they could advocate their interests in game species such as marlin, broadbill, sharks and kingfish. Over time the NZSFC has expanded its advocacy to a wider range of species, issues of national interest, and environmental protection. This expanded workload reflects the broader affiliated member base from both the North and South Islands.

This record is a preliminary summary of NZSFC submissions made from 2009 onwards, in response to management, policy or science processes of relevance to the North Island, including some national issues. It is preliminary because the online records are incomplete and some details have been lost over time. Updates are added as required, currently, this is our best attempt to capture the advocacy for North Island fishing interests.

In 2012 the NZSFC established LegaSea to raise public awareness about the issues affecting our marine environment, what's at stake both regionally and nationally. LegaSea has become adept at encouraging alignment amongst like-minded people and organisations.

LegaSea is also inspiring people to contribute financially to help spread the load of resourcing our advocacy effort. Since inception, LegaSea has operated a 100% Commitment Policy whereby all public donations and unaffiliated club contributions are distributed to the NZSFC to be administered by the Fisheries Management Standing Committee and spent on advocacy, research, education and alignment. These four work streams feed into the NZSFC submissions.

To keep this digestible, this chronological summary of submissions excludes attendances at meetings, Working Group, research and management discussions, and engagement in other processes.
