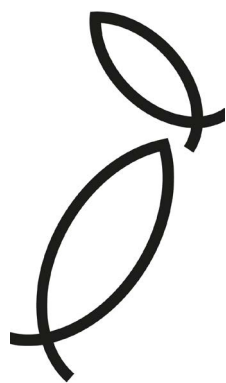

Fisheries scientist

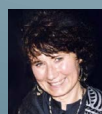
