## Review of fisheries sustainability measures for 1 October 2016

The Ministry for Primary Industries (MPI) is seeking feedback from tangata whenua and stakeholders on proposed changes to sustainability measures and management controls for selected fishstocks.

Reviews of sustainability measures and other management controls for selected fishstocks is an annual process. This is consistent with the requirement to ensure sustainable utilisation of fisheries resources.

The proposals for each stock have been assessed in the context of the relevant statutory requirements and the best available information, including (where relevant) the latest scientific information on the status of the stocks and tangata whenua and stakeholder input.
